Information Technology Vocabulary


Information technology	Information technology (IT) is the use of computers to store, save and communicate information
computer networks	Two or more computers that are connected with one another
internet	The internet is a huge network of computers all connected together
World Wide Web	The world wide web ('www' or 'web' for short) is a collection of webpages found on lots of computers
communication	Taking part in exchanging information, ideas and feelings
collaboration	The action of working together with someone to produce something
online information	Online information is found, on the internet, viewed and understood
privacy	Someone's right to keep their personal matters and relationships secret
security	To keep all the information stored on a computer or on the internet safe
copyright	Copyright is a legal protection extended to those who produce creative works
ownership	Something that belongs to you


