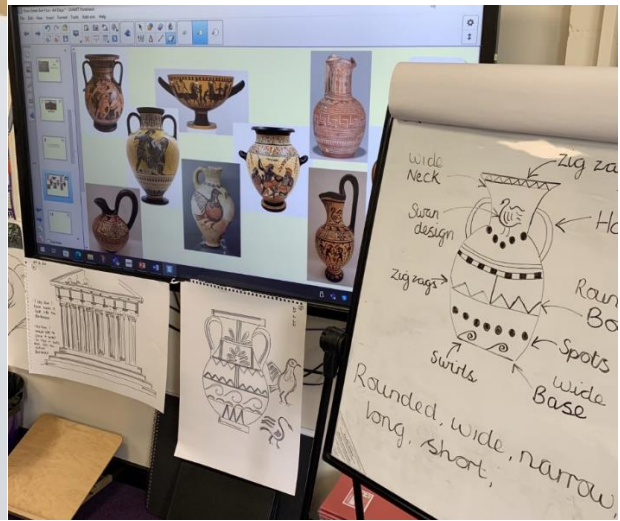
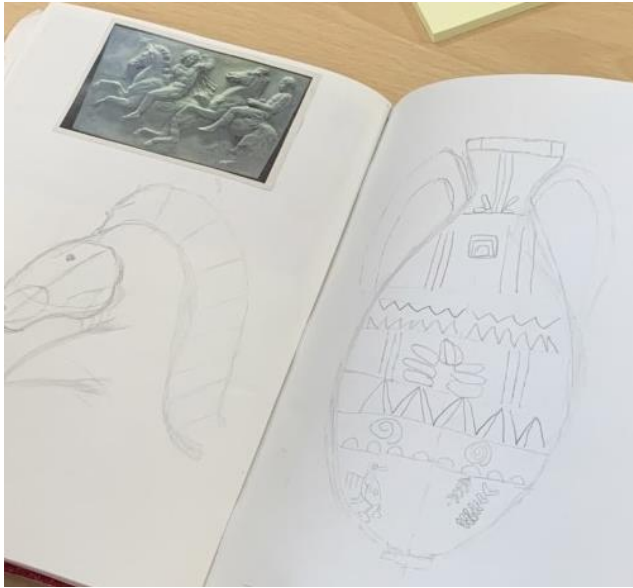
MR. WYATT
