Andokides was a famous potter of Ancient Greece. The painter of the pots, he created was an anonymous antist. The Andokides painter is necognized as the creater of the red-figure style. His work is compared with Exekias, who was, said to have created the most detailed and best exampless of black-figure pottery. The most renowned work of Andokides is the amphora depicting the god Dionysus and two of his maenads. Greek sculpture was meant to show perfection. They wanted to create lifelike images of nean perfect humans. Unlike the Romans, the Greeks never showed human imperfections in their ant.
