### SAFER INTERNET DAY – TUESDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY

Next week is safer internet day. Safer Internet Day is celebrated globally in February each year to promote the safe and positive use of digital technology for children and young people, and to

inspire a national conversation about using technology responsibly, respectfully, critically, and creatively. The theme this year is: All fun and games? Exploring respect and relationships online. In assembly this week, we discussed what this means and how we show respect and develop positive relationships online, regardless of our differences. For example, listening to others, understanding someone might not want the same thing as you, thinking about our words and actions might make others feel etc. We also discussed how children should stay safe online, such as: Not sharing personal information, thinking carefully before they post anything, is the website secure? Reliable? Never meeting up with someone they have only met online etc.

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In this assembly (with Years 1 -6) I launched a safer internet poster competition.

Design a poster that:

- Shares key messages for safer internet use
- Promotes respectful internet use (Treating everyone equally)
- Tells someone what to do if they have concerns (Tell someone!).

The Year 5 Digital Leaders will pick a winning entry from each class that will be used as a screen saver on the teachers computer so that it is always on the big screen in each classroom and each one will be on the main screen in the main entrance. This will be used to remind children about how to stay safe online and use the internet respectfully.

Children have until Monday to bring in their entries. Please encourage your children to enter – they can be done by hand or electronically. If you require any paper etc, please let the class teacher now and they will provide some supplies. Children will be focusing on safer internet use during lessons on Tuesday.



As parents/carers, if you would like additional information there is a safer internet event on You Tube at 4:30pm on Tuesday. Find out about what games are appropriate for children? What are the advantages and disadvantages of gaming? Sophie Linington (Internet safety expert) will explore some of the most frequent questions parents have about gaming.
