Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you are all well and enjoying the lovely weather. As you all know, today is the last day of the current classes; most children start with their new teacher from Monday. I have provided some of the key information again within this newsletter.

COVID-19 AND HEATHFIELD IN SEPTEMBER

As COVID-19 becomes a virus that we learn to live with, in September we anticipate school will on the whole go back to how it was pre pandemic. We will still have some controls in place:

- Ensure good hygiene for everyone
- Maintaing appropriate cleaning regimes
- Good ventiliation
- Follow public health advice on tetsing, self isolation and managing confirmed cases

These measures will certainly be less disruptive to children's eductuion; from 16th August 2021, children under the age 18 years old will no longer be required to self isolate. I will update you on the specifics of how this will look at Heathfield towards the end of the summer holiday to ensure we can take into account most recent advice.

Please note, despite easing of restrictions from Monday 19th July, school will continue to follow all procedures and controls that we currently employ until the last day of term. This includes bubble closure, if required.

Children in Year 3 will be taught by Mrs. Walters as a virtual teacher and Mr. Helsby will be the physical teacher in the classroom.

Children in current Year 6 will enter the school via the year 5 classroom door and leave via this door at 3:15pm.

Families with children across Years 1 - 6 can continue to drop off at the earliest time and collect and the latest time.

Children in Nursery that will be starting in the Heathfield Reception class will go the Reception class external door at the front of the Early Years building in line with the times they do now. For example, if your child currently starts Nursery at 8:30am, then they will arrive at their new reception class for 8:30am.

Children in First Steps that will be starting in the Heathfield Nursery class will go to Nursery at the times they currently do in First Steps.

There are no changes for children that are remaining in First Steps or Nursery or for children leaving at the end of the academic year to attend different provision.


