

Art & Design: What makes a hero super?

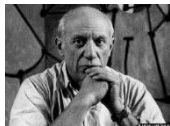
What should I already know?

In Reception, we learnt about various artists such as Giuseppe Archimbaldo who was an Italian painter best known for creating imaginative portrait heads made entirely of objects such as fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish and books, Henry Matisse a French artist who was a draughtsman, printmaker, and sculptor, but is known primarily as a painter and Piet Mondrian a Dutch artist best known for his abstract paintings In Autumn term we looked at Nicholas Hilliard artwork. We have learned skills linked to making sculptures using natural and materials from our surroundings.
