<p>W A R M U P</p>	 Hello everyone, we are going to have some fun with our music today thinking about planting and growing. Let's warm up with up "I am a seed" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2vIua3fWwRI Did you manage to get lots of energy into your warm up? Maybe you could create your own "seed journey" and share it with your class.
<p>S I N G I N G</p>	Here's a song for you to sing. See if you can work out what famous Roald Dahl book it was inspired by. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=96JDkI2tBhI The words are on the screen for you to sing along with. Try to perform it with your own actions. What did you learn about growing? What will you do when you grow up?
<p>A C T I V I T I E S</p>	Watch this video - it is a speeded up version of a seed growing. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=iZMjBO6A7AE Can you create 4 movements which show how the seed grows? Now see if you can add body sounds or vocal beat boxing type sounds to match your movements. This should create a musical pattern. Use this app to try to work out how the notes getting higher might help to describe growth. https://virtualpiano.net/ Can you add this to your vocal pattern? Can you get an adult to video your ideas? What did you think when you watched your work? How would you change it to make it better?

Activities: If you don't have access to a computer, don't worry, you will have a lot of "junk" instruments around the house you could use. You could research an instrument to make or even performers who just use things they find in their home.
