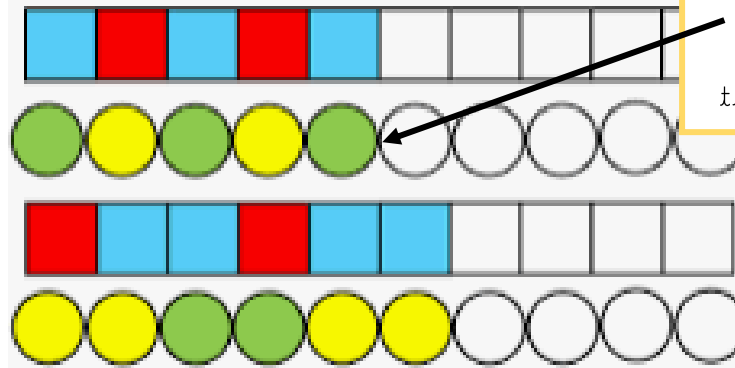

Key Vocabulary

2D shape	Shapes that are completely flat. They are made up of straight sides and corners or curved lines.
routine	A usual order or way of doing something
morning	The earliest part of the day, usually when you wake up
evening	The final part of the day, usually before bedtime.

Shape is everywhere. It is important to remember objects we see may be similar to a known 2D shape, however, they are not a 2D shape.
