### Key vocabulary:

**city** a large town. London is a city.

**compass point** any of the main points of a compass: north, south, east and west

**continent** a very large area of land that consists of many countries. Europe is a conti

**country** an area of land that is controlled by its own government.

**island** a piece of land that is completely surrounded by water .

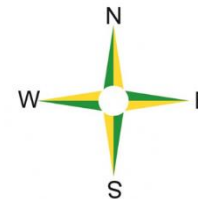
**ocean** one of the five very large areas of salt water on the Earth's surface.

**sea** a large area of salty water that is part of an ocean surrounded to be present all around

**village** a small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside.

**town** a place where people live and work, containing many houses, shops. It is smaller than a city.

**river** a large, flowing body of water that usually empties into a sea or ocean.
