island a piece of land that is completely surrounded by water.

ocean one of the five very large areas of salt water on the Earth's surface.

sea a large area of salty water that is part of an ocean surrounded to be present all around village a small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside.

town a place where people live and work, containing many houses, shops. It is smaller than a city. river a large, flowing body of water that usually empties into a sea or ocean.
