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Geography-4 raffle tickets

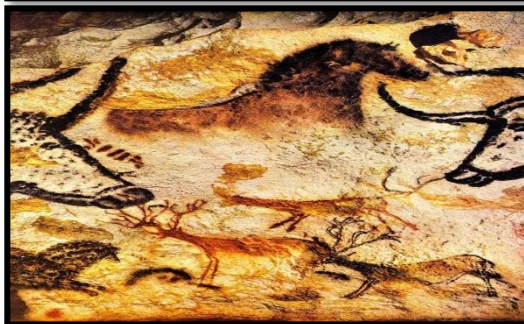
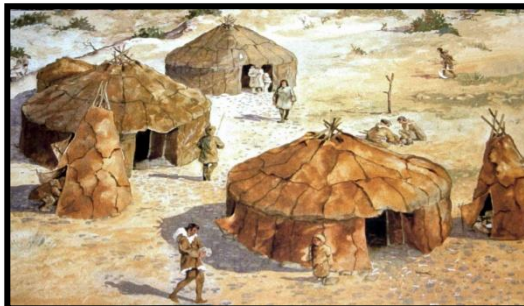
Find out where the best places to build Iron Age settlements were and why. Can you find these on a map?
