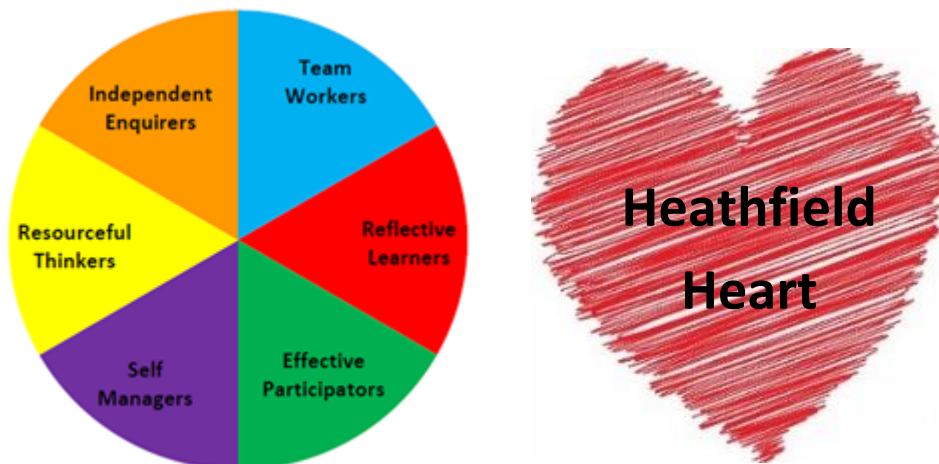


## Key Concepts
