COVID-19

Overall, Heathfield has enjoyed a quiet half term with regards to COVID-19 infections. However, we must remember that the virus has not gone away and take proactive measures to ensure the safety of everyone in the Heathfield family and to allow education to continue as normal.

COVID rates, both locally and nationally are increasing and so we need to be as proactive as possible to limit the spread of the virus.
