Artist: we will be creating Stone Age cave paintings using sketching techniques, tone, form, composition and observational drawings. Children will also create patterns.



Scientist: animals including humans.
We will be finding out about nutrition
and finding out how humans and some
animals have skeletons and muscles for
support, protection and movement.

Historian: we will be finding out the changes in Britan from the Stone Age to Iron Age. This will include early farming, hunter-gatherers and life in a settlement.

Showcase: At the end of the learning challenge, Year 3 will be creating a human museum to showcase their knowledge of prehistoric Britain and the changes that occurred from the Stone Age to Iron Age.

Geographer: we will be exploring settlements in the U.K and land Use. We will be studying the location using maps and growth and nature of the settlements using our knowledge of physical and human geography.

Linguists As linguists we will be exploring how to choose and prepare poems and stories for performance, identifying appropriate expression, tone, and volume.



Writer: we will be writing an adventure story based on The Stone Age Boy. We will also be looking at instructions and a non-chronological report. We will also look at a range of fables.

Mathematician:

This term in maths we will be studying numbers to 10 000 including place value, addition and subtraction. We will also be practicing multiplying and dividing numbers.
