Put wood in th'ole – shut the door

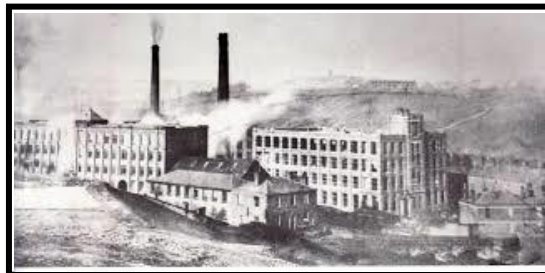
