Communication and Language

- I can listen to a longer story and remember much of what happens
- I am beginning to join up my sentences
- I respond to questions and instructions



Physical Development

- I can copy letters from my name
- I can run and avoid large obstacles
- I can move freely, with confidence and pleasure, in a variety of ways
- I can momentarily stand on one foot when shown

Personal, Social and Emotion Development

- I am beginning to be independent in meeting my own care needs i.e. toileting, handwashing
- I can confidently ask adults for help
- I know some actions or words can hurt others' feelings
- I initial play and offer cues for others to join in

Literacy

- I am beginning to hear and say the initial sound in words
- I can begin to recall a sequence of events from stories I hear
