Artist:

We will be practising line drawings and shading skills, based around the theme of autumn and winter. We will also study Andy Goldsworthy and his techniques, producing our own nature inspired pieces of art.

Showcase:

Share our learning with Reception children by creating a fact file for the history of transport

Scientist:

Materials - we will be sorting materials based on their properties, through grouping and investigation.

Seasonal change - we will explore the changes through the 2 seasons; autumn and winter. We will also create pieces of art to represent each season.

<u>Historiani</u>

We will be learning about the history of transport, comparing and contrasting old and new modes of transport. This will incorporate a study on the famous Wright Brothers and Amy

Mathematician:

This term in maths we will be studying numbers to 20 including place value, number bonds, addition and subtraction. We will also learn about the properties of 2D shapes

Modern Foreign Language: Spanish

As part of our whole school Spanish day, we will learn about the Spanish culture including where it is, Spanish food and dance.

Religious Education:

As part of our RE this term, we will be looking at Christianity. We will be learning about:

Who created the world

Why we should look after our world

What is special to us

All about Christmas

Physical Education:

We will be using Key PE Sports to plan and deliver PE. We will be learning to develop speed, agility and quickness. We will also improve our core strength by exploring balance and different ways to move (e.g. crawling, rolling)

Music:

We will be using the Charanga music scheme to plan and deliver music. Year I will be listening to and appraising a range of music including rap and reggae. We will learn to use vocabulary such as pulse, beat and pitch, as well as using different instruments to express the music genre.

Character Development:
