Artist: we will be creating Stone Age cave paintings using sketching techniques, tone, form, composition and observational drawings. Children will also create patterns.



Scientisti

We will be looking at the importance of light in our everyday life and how shadows are formed. During animals including humans we will be finding out about nutrition and how humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Historian: we will be finding out the changes in Britan from the Stone Age to Iron Age. This will include early farming, hunter-gatherers and life in a settlement.

Showcase: At the end of the learning challenge, Year 3 will be creating a human museum to showcase their knowledge of prehistoric Britain and the changes that occurred from the Stone Age to Iron Age.

Prime LC: Who first lived in Britain?

UN Links: article-31-All children have the right to relax and play, and to join in with a wide range of activities

Geographer: we will be exploring settlements in the U.K and land Use. We will be studying the location using maps and growth and nature of the settlements using our knowledge of physical and human

Geography.

Reader: We will be reading a range of texts this term including fiction and non-fiction. Some of our favourites are, Stone Age Boy, How to wash a woolly mammoth and UG. Please see the Year 3 eSchools page for additional reading texts.



Linguist: As linguists we will be exploring how to choose and prepare poems and stories for performance, identifying appropriate expression, tone, and volume.



Writer: we will be writing an adventure story based on The Stone Age Boy. We will also be looking at instructions and a non-chronological report. We will also look at a range of fables.



Mathematician: This term in maths we will be studying numbers to 10 000 including place value, addition and subtraction. We will also be practicing multiplying and dividing numbers.



Modern Foreign Language: Spanish

Year 3 will be learning basic Spanish vocabulary including greetings, feelings numbers, and colours. The children will also be learning about Spanish traditions including Christmas.



Character Development: through our learning challenge curriculum. we will be investigating and discussing how the Stone Age people showed resilience in the face of extreme climate change and living conditions.

Religious Education: We will be following a scheme of work that will first focus on Judaism and we will learn about the traditions and culture within this festival.



Physical Education: We will be using Key PE Sports to plan and deliver PE. We will be learning to develop of speed, agility and quickness.



Prime LC: Who first lived in Britain?

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Designer: We will be evaluating existing products, planning, designing and making Stone Age fishing net using a range of natural resources.



Music: We will be using the Charanga music scheme to plan and deliver music. In the autumn term Year 3 will be listening to and appraising a range of musical vocabulary. Children will also be reading musical notes and composing their own music. On some Fridays during the term we will be doing the Big Sing with Bolton Music Service.

PSHE: We will be following the Jigsaw scheme and focusing on 'Being me in my world' and 'Celebrating Differences'
