SPORTS DAY

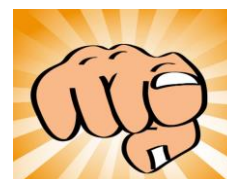
Children across school competed in Sports Day this week, taking part in a range of sporting challenges.
