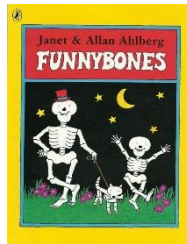
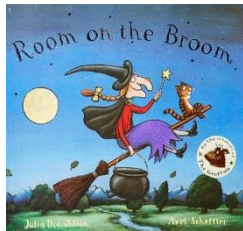

Blending	Blending in phonics is combining broken up sounds to make a word. For example, you hear 'p-i-g' and you merge these sounds together to make the single word 'pig'.
Segmenting	Segmenting is the ability to hear the individual sounds in words.
Sequencing	Sequencing is putting the story into the right order with a beginning, middle and end.
CVC words	Three letter words with a consonant, vowel and consonant pattern. They can easily be blended and segmented for reading and writing.
Tricky words	Words that cannot be blended or segmented. For example; go, I, the, to, no.
Seasons	The changing times of the year with changes in the natural world and the weather.
