
Use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have the butterfly feeling

Information Technology Vocabulary

Information technology	Information technology (IT) is using computers to store, save and communicate information
computer networks	Computers that are connected
internet	The internet is a huge network of computers connected together
World Wide Web	The world wide web ('www' or 'web' for short) is a collection of webpages found on the internet
communication	Talking to friends either face to face or using technology
collaboration	Working together to produce something
online information	Can be found on the internet and viewed understood
personal information	To keep their personal information private
ownership	Something that belongs to you

IT.EYFS.6 name my work so that others know it belongs to me


What should you do if you get a 'butterfly' feeling when online?
