


Maths Knowledge Organiser

Dot patterns can be used to identify more, less and the same. They also support children's understanding of number.



Key Vocabulary	
'ness' of a number	i.e. the 'fiveness of five'. This supports children to explore the existence of a number.
comparison	To look at what is similar or different
identical	Being exactly alike or equal
same	Exactly like another
