Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are safe and well.

As you will be aware, we have remained open for the children of key workers and vulnerable children and since the 2<sup>nd</sup> June we have welcomed more children back from Year 6, Year 1, Reception and Nursery. The return of more children has gone according to plan. The children who have returned have staggered start and finish times, are taught in smaller, separate teams and staff and children are maintaining social distancing, where this is appropriate. We have put in place additional hygiene and infection control measures and our arrangements are under regular review to ensure the highest level of safety of everyone in the Heathfield family. We are constantly reviewing our staffing options to invite additional year groups into school.

## **Summer Holidays**

Heathfield will not be open over the summer holidays. Governors and the local authority strongly believe that the Heathfield staff need this break so that they can recharge their batteries and be ready and energized to welcome back all children in September. I strongly agree with this – the Heathfield staff have worked tremendously hard. Bolton Council have confirmed this week that they will be providing child care for key worker parents at various locations across Bolton. There will be a charge for this. As soon as more information is made available, I will forward it to parents/carers. Free School meal vouchers will be available over the summer holidays.
