## **RECEPTION and YEAR 1 PARENT PHONIC MEETING**

Reading and teaching children to read is **THE MOST IMPORTANT thing** we do at Heathfield. Even on Christmas Party day, reading and phonic lessons continue. At Heathfield, reading is not considered a subject but a vital skill that opens up all the other areas of the curriculum.

#### Knowledge + Reading strategy = skilled reader

Knowledge refers to our broad and balanced curriculum; giving children the knowledge and skills to help them understand and comprehend text

Reading strategy refers to the specific reading skills decoding, blending, segmenting, fluency, expression, retrieval, inference to name a few

## Knowledge and reading strategy combined results in a skilled Heathfield reader.

As a school we have worked hard to develop our phonics and reading curriculum. With this in mind, we have arranged a virtual meeting for Reception and Year 1 Parents to explain how we teach phonics at Heathfield and how you can support your child at home.

## **READING PLUS**

Some of you will be aware that we in Key Stage 2, we use an online package called Reading Plus as part of our reading curriculum. Reading Plus is an online reading programme that's packed full of engaging texts for pupils to explore and enjoy. It teaches silent reading fluency, comprehension, and vocabulary with software that meets each child's individual reading level. All children have an individual log in. All Key stage 2 children use reading plus in school but it would really help if parents/carers could encourage children to access Reading Plus at home to help develop their reading fluency and comprehension. Reading Plus works on most devices.
