RE: REMOTE LEARNING - HOW TO USE MICROSOFT TEAMS - YEARS 1 -6

Dear Parent/Carer, I hope everyone is safe and well.

As many of you will already know, if individual children are self-isolating or a class is required to close as a result of COVID-19, we are building a strong contingency plan to allow for remote learning to take place.

Recently, we had to close Year 6. 93% of the children in Year 6 consistently engaged with remote learning using Miscrosft teams. Nothing can replace physically attending school but nevertheless the children were able to move forwards in their learning as a result of our remote learning offer.

At Heathfield, the team have worked incredibly hard to put our Remote Learning package together and we are learning quickly what is working well.

To ensure that parents can use Microsoft Teams, we are hosting two sessions next week that will be really useful for parents should your child need to self-isolate and/or is already self – isolating. We feel it is much better to be prepared! The session will focus on showing parents how their children can log in, view and hand in work, and use the chat functions to talk to the class teachers and other students. You will also have an opportunity to ask any questions you may have about Microsoft Teams during this session.
